Minutes

In attendance were Mayor Lynn Rumley, Commissioners Jean Snead, Brad Waller, Scott Vogler, Tommy Daywalt and Clerk John Chandler

Mayor Lynn Rumley called the meeting to order.

Invocation: Clerk Chandler

Mayor led us all in the Pledge to the US Flag.

Motion made by Commissioner Snead to adopt the Agenda which includes the Consent Agenda.

Seconded by Commissioner Waller

Vote was unanimous.

Tronia Gibson spoke on the possibility of the Town adopting a Fence Ordinance. She feels we will wish we had a fence ordinance when someone builds something unsightly. The Mayor said she did not feel the Code Enforcement officer could take the time to research a Fence Ordinance at this time. Commissioner Vogler said he would do the research and report back later.

Commissioner Vogler to add item #8 to the agenda to speak on a ditch problem.

Board Comments to be added as item #11

Motion made by Commissioner Snead to adopt the Agenda which includes the Consent Agenda.

Seconded by Commissioner Waller

Vote was unanimous.

Commissioner Vogler reported there was a deep ditch in front of the Lonnie Barnes house at 204 Watt Street that the State DOT had dug out when working in that area a year or so ago.

Commissioner Vogler asked for the Board's approval, to culvert the ditch and possibly add a drop inlet. The Board felt if the cost was within the amount Vogler can spend and that he should make that decision.

The Clerk presented the Board with Budget Amendments and Budget Transfers for the FY year 2013/2014

Motion by Commissioner Daywalt that the Budget Amendments BA-01 and BA-02 be approved.

Seconded by Commissioner Snead

Vote was unanimous.

The Clerk passed out a Police Calendar spreadsheet that shows how much money the Police Dept. has accumulated since they have been selling the calendars. This money has accumulated to \$5,000.00 that can be rolled over to the next year. A schedule is attached to these minutes.

The Clerk began discussion of the Proposed FY 2014/2015 Town Budget. He read Budget Message to the Board and handed out a new Proposed Budget Worksheet to each elected official. After going over all Proposed Revenues and Expenses the Board seemed to think the budget work was in good order.

Motion made by Commissioner Waller to set the FY 2014/2015 Budget Public Hearing for Monday June 16th at 7:00 pm. This will be just after the Regular Town Board Meeting.
