Minutes

In attendance were Mayor Elect- Steve Corriher, Commissioners Elect: Jessica Almond, Daphne Beck, Karen "KC" Smith, and Commissioner Brad Waller, and Clerk John Chandler. Special Guest was Magistrate, David Miller and the Boy Scout Troop 576.

Clerk Chandler introduced the Agenda for the evening. Davie County Magistrate, David Miller began by bringing up each Elected official one at a time. Listed below is those elected officials that took the Oath of Office this evening.

Regular Meeting (began)

Mayor Steve Corriher called the meeting to order.

Boy Scout Troop 576 lead in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag

Visitors were welcomed by the Mayor.

Motion made by Commissioner Beck to adopt the Agenda.

Vote was unanimous.

Public Comment: Eric Wertz of Davie Street spoke on a continued problem of speeders on Davie Street. Children at the school bus stop are at danger. He knows the police are trying to help, but he thinks that speed bumps would help curb the speeding. He strongly urged the Board to do something about this problem.

Chief Bobby West presented a request for a grant for the Police Department in the amount of \$24,500.00 for technology. This is a non-matching grant.

Motion made by Commissioner Almond to proceed with the grant.
Seconded by Commissioner Smith.
Vote was unanimous.

Code Enforcement Officer, George Madeja presented the Board with a proposed Automobile Ordinance. Each Board Member was given a copy of this proposal. He asked the Board to look over the proposal between now and the January meeting, hopefully ready to pass the ordinance. Basically the task for this ordinance was to help eliminate junk automobiles. Madeja explained in brief some of the things addressed in the proposal.

The Mayor addressed the Board about a possible re-appointment to the ABC Board. James Wishon has applied to be reappointed.
Motion made by Commissioner Beck to reappoint James Wishon to this position.
Seconded by Commissioner Waller
Vote was unanimous.

Mayor Corriher and the rest of the Board spoke among each other and to the public how excited they are to work for the Town. Their main objectives were given which in summary were to build community spirit, clean up the Town with ordinances and education. With the assets this Town has the consensus was we can accomplish most anything.
