Minutes

In attendance were Mayor Steve Corriher, Commissioners: Jessica Almond, Daphne Beck, KC Smith, Brad Waller and Town Clerk John Chandler

Mayor Steve Corriher called the meeting to order.

Motion made by Commissioner Smith that the Resolution to 401K be added to 6.a of the agenda.
Seconded by Commissioner Waller
Vote was unanimous

Motion made by Commissioner Waller to adopt the agenda as amended.
Seconded by Commissioner Daywalt
Vote was unanimous

Public Comment: Ms. Sue Steele spoke on the ordinance book that is in the library was not up to date, but has since noticed the book has been updated. She continued that most citizens cannot read the book and understand it. She said she thought, according to the ordinance book, that the police was to support all ordinances and we have no need of a Code Enforcement person.

Commissioner Smith read the proposed Resolution adding all employees to the 401K Retirement Plan. (copy attached to these minutes)

Motion made by Commissioner Beck that Board Resolution of the 401K Retirement Plan be approved.
Seconded by Commissioner Daywalt
Vote was unanimous

Motion made by Commissioner Daywalt that Grimes Parker be appointed to the ABC Board.
Seconded by Commissioner Waller
Vote was 3 to 1 with Commissioner Smith in opposition

The Mayor asked to be a delegate to talk with possible candidates to do our code enforcement. He felt something needed to be done by a professional that can handle certain things such as Minimum Housing. He specifically wants to talk with ACE Co. again and see if something could be worked out. Commissioner Smith said she would be willing to be included in these conversations. She was also unclear of what our Police Dept. does in regards to code enforcement. Commissioner Waller said

Motion made by Commissioner Waller that Mayor Corriher and Commissioner Smith interview for Code Enforcement and that this position be posted.

Seconded by Commissioner Daywalt.

Vote was unanimous

Commissioner Smith handed out information on the proposed basketball court renovations.

She said all workers for demolition and reconstruction are ready. (ideas of basketball goals are attached to these minutes)

Smith spoke of many different uses of Town property for other types of sporting events such as using the tennis courts for basketball, pickle-ball, etc.

Motion made by Commissioner Smith to approve to have Breck Bullock and Justin Draughn to proceed after July 1st with demolition of old basketball court and keeping the existing goals with plans to replace the backboards when needed and to eventually build the new court out of concrete.

Seconded by Commissioner Beck

Vote was unanimous.

Motion made by Commissioner Waller to adjourn
