

Workshop Meeting
Town of Cooleemee
August 22, 2016 6:00 pm
Minutes

In attendance were Mayor Steve Corriher, Commissioners: Jessica Almond, Daphne Beck, KC Smith, Brad Waller and Town Clerk John Chandler

Mayor Steve Corriher called the meeting to order.

The Cooleemee Town Board received a request from Mr. Camille Mardini to approve a continuation of his license to sell beer at 7682 Hwy. 801 S. in Cooleemee, N.C.

Motion made by Commissioner Smith to approve the Resolution to the N.C. Alcoholic Beverage Control Commissioner that would allow Camille Mardini to be permitted to sell beer.

Seconded by Commissioner Beck.

Vote was unanimous

Finance Officer reported that Smith Davis Foundation had made a gift to the Town of Cooleemee. One check earmarked to the Town for Recreation in the amount of \$ 5,000.00 and another check earmarked to the Cooleemee Police Dept. in the amount of \$ 3,000.00.

The \$5,000 is to be spent on any recreational needs.

The \$3,000 is to be spent on police supplies such as ammunition, bullet prove vest, etc. He specifically asked it not be spent toward automobiles.

The Mayor spoke to the Board about the procedures and Board responses to questions and motions that come up in regular meetings.

Mayor Corriher wants to sit down with the police department to discuss various things. He feels the police chief is a bit disgruntled about a few things and the Mayor wants to talk with all of them.

There was much discussion on how Holiday pay was paid verses regular pay, and how was the Chiefs sick and vacation time kept up with.

Discussion continued in regards to Town Ordinances and how the police are responding to these issues. In particular were cars that are parked on the road and speeding vehicles.

The Board continued speaking about several ordinance violations and general town property maintenance, such as broken bottles on pathways, and brush thrown onto Town property.

The Mayor will set up dates to meet with the Police Dept. Employees individually.
