Welcome to Cooleemee!

You live in one of the most peaceful neighborhoods I know of or you may own property and rent to someone who does and maybe you are just considering moving here. There have been many changes in our town over the years and many of us have vowed to do our part to help keep it a wonderful place to live. If you have just moved here or been here a while, the Town wants you to live comfortably and peaceful.

The Town owns a very large park called RiverPark at Cooleemee Falls. Many of us call it the "Bullhole", named from an old legend. It is still under construction as we have yet to finish the "Cooleemee side" of the park. Please be sure to visit there soon, it is open year round.



Most all the history of the town is kept in the Cooleemee Historical Association main museum at 131 Church Street. You will find lots of photos, memorabilia and ephemera that will excite the history buff. The C.H.A. has even created a Mill House Museum located nearby that takes you into a house that looks exactly like the mill houses looked in 1930.







Walking is a great pastime and a good way to get exercise. Many of our neighbors walk in the cool of the evening. This is a great way to meet one another along the way, or stopping by chatting with those who find their front porch a nice place to relax after supper.

Listed are some of our Ordinances:

- *Cooleemee does have a leash law for animals. Many people walk in Town, for exercise or just for the fresh air. Take your dog along with you, but don't forget the leash. Most people do, but it is a law that you clean up after your dog.
- * A burning permit is needed to burn inside the Town Limits. Get one at Town Hall. There is no cost for the permit.
- *The speed Limit inside Cooleemee is 25 miles per hour unless otherwise posted. This is strictly enforced
- * We have weekly garbage pickup on Friday mornings early. Most citizens put their garbage cans at curbside on Thursday night. Republic Services provides trash containers. One is for household garbage, the other is for recycle material. Also containers cannot be placed at curbside earlier than 24 hours before pickup. Containers must be taken to the rear of your house no later than 24 hours after pickup. Household garbage is picked up every Friday. Recycle is picked up every other Friday.
- *There is a youth curfew in Town. Sunday through Thursdays.10 pm -6 am. Friday & Saturday it is 11 pm 6 am
- *You need a permit to have a yard sale. Three weekends per year is the limit. Check with Town Hall. There is no fee for a Yard Sale Permit.

- * Permits are needed if you want to improve your property with a new deck, porch or outbuilding or fence, carport of addition to your house. Check with Town Hall as to whether you need a Cooleemee permit and or a Davie County permit.
- *Even though you may see some, street mailboxes are not allowed at your residence. You can rent a post office box at the local Post Office for around \$48.00 per year.
- *Fences can be a beautiful accent to your home. If you are thinking about adding one, contact the Town Hall to see how you can get a permit to build a fence.
- *Open storage of any items is unlawful. Porches are to be clear of any type of storage. The only furniture allowed on a front porch is furniture that is designed for outdoor use. Recreational fire-pits are not allowed in front yards.
- *Paved parking areas are the only place you may park or store your automobile. The area must be designated as a parking area. Paved with stone, concrete, or asphalt and kept maintained.

As a special note we know that most people have no problem with these ordinances and are glad they are in effect. A cluttered yard around your house or on your porch is not being polite to your neighbors. We know these types of violations decrease your property value and your neighbors value. Cooleemee is a unique little town. We want you living in peace and comfort as long as you live here.
