Minutes

In attendance were Mayor Steve Corriher, Commissioners: Jessica Almond, Daphne Beck, KC Smith, Andy Reavis and Town Clerk John Chandler

Mayor Steve Corriher called the meeting to order.

Invocation: Clerk John Chandler

Pledge to the US Flag.

Visitors were welcomed.

Commissioner Beck made a motion to eliminate item 5 from the agenda that states Vote to go into Executive Session.

Vote was unanimous

Motion made by Commissioner to add 5.B under the Consent agenda to state August 21st minutes.
