

Regular Meeting
Town of Cooleemee
January 15, 2018 6:00 pm
Minutes

In attendance were Mayor Steve Corriher, Commissioners: Don Cover, KC Smith, Andy Reavis
Commissioner Almond was absent due to sickness.

Mayor Steve Corriher called the meeting to order.
Invocation: John Chandler (the chaplain was absent due to sickness)
Pledge to the US Flag.

Visitors were welcomed.

Motion made by Commissioner Reavis to adopt the agenda.
Seconded by Commissioner Smith
Vote was unanimous

No one had signed up to speak during the public speaking time.

Commissioner Beck who has come off the board because of the last election, leaves a vacancy
for the Public Works.

Motion made by Commissioner Reavis to appoint Commissioner Cover to this liaison position.
Seconded by Commissioner Smith.
Vote was unanimous

Motion made by Commissioner Smith to appoint Commissioner Almond as the Mayor ProTem
position.

Seconded by Commissioner Cover
Vote was unanimous.

(Commissioner Almond was absent from the meeting but she had been previously asked by the
Mayor if she would accept the position, of which she said yes.)

Due to a problem with cars going off the road at a Dead End on Joyner St. and going onto private
property behind the Dollar Store. He suggested that a sign could be put up at the end of the road
that says "Dead End"

There was no decision made, but to wait until there was contact with her.

The Mayor reported to the Board where the ABC Store merging was. The Mayor said that the
ABC Commissioner highly recommended a "merger". Choosing the name of the store, location,
board appointments etc. will come later. Mocksville wants to go along with the Merger.
Deciding the ways to divide the profits will be a major decision. The Town Attorney will
become a part of negotiations. More meetings will be planned on the negotiations in the months
to come.

Motion made by Commissioner Cover that the Cooleemee Town Board will meet every third Monday of each month at 6:00pm
Seconded by Commissioner Reavis
Vote was unanimous.

Commissioner Smith reported on the Davie County Recreation Grant being offered. An email was sent to all commissioners explaining the grant. She highly recommended everyone read the policy section of the grant. This is not a part of the money the Town usually gets every year, which usually comes to about \$ 7,700.00
It is important that everyone becomes involved in coming up with needs in the Recreation part of our town. February is approaching fast and the Grant will be due in February.

Commissioner Smith spoke with a resident on Main St. that was told she could not park on the street. The area is curbed. Smith wanted to verify the resident could park there. The Mayor said yes as long as there is a curb in front of her house. Commissioner Smith said she would let the resident know for sure.

Commissioner Smith made a motion to adjourn.
