

Regular Meeting
Town of Cooleemee
March 19, 2018 6:00 pm
Minutes

In attendance were Mayor Steve Corriher, Commissioners: Don Cover, KC Smith, Andy Reavis
Commissioner Almond and Clerk John Chandler

Mayor Steve Corriher called the meeting to order.
Invocation: Clayton Briggs, Chaplin
Pledge to the US Flag.

Visitors were welcomed.

Motion made by Commissioner Smith to accept the Agenda which includes the Consent Agenda.
Seconded by Commissioner Reavis.
Vote was unanimous.

Public Comments: Joyce _____ stated that she is having problems with the cable down here.
She said they do not recognize Cooleemee as a place. The Mayor said he would look into it.

Departmental Reports:

Code Enforcement: A report was given by officer, Brandon Emory. He elaborated on some of
his violations. Written reports were in the packet.

Community Relations:

Senior games have set a date for the Opening Ceremony, as Thursday, April 12th at 4:30 at the
YMCA Mocksville. They have asked for representatives from each town to be there.
Commissioner Smith said she was organizing the horseshoe pits repairs.

New Business:

The Finance officer passed out a request for a Budget Amendment to increase Attorney fees.
Motion made by Commissioner Reavis to approve a Budget Amendment to increase the
Attorney Fees by \$3,000.00
Seconded by Commissioner Cover.
Vote was unanimous.

Old Business:

The Mayor gave a report on the possible ABC merger between Cooleemee and Mocksville.
Several negotiation meeting have been held. In the negotiations the Mayor Corriher asked that
the ABC board membership rotates between the two towns. 3 board members from Cooleemee
and 2 from Mocksville, then rotates 2 from Cooleemee and 3 from Mocksville and so on. Things
seemed to be settled between Mocksville and Cooleemee at the last meeting with Mayor

Markland and Town Manager Marcus Abernathy. They took it to their board and it was not agreed upon. They still have some problems with an agreement. Mayor Corriher was speaking for the Town Board of Cooleemee and he is feeling there would be no more negotiations.

Other Board Comments:

Commissioner Reavis brought to the board a concern, that he will not be able to build an accessory building the size he wants it due to a limit on the square footage on a lot with a house. The lot beside him has a house on it that he intends to demolish. He is going to combine his lot with the lot beside him.

Motion made by Commissioner Smith that a 200 square foot allowance be given to Andy Reavis so he can build the size building he wants.

Seconded by Commissioner Almond.

Vote was unanimous.

Commissioner announced the upcoming Easter Egg Hunt set for Saturday March 31st.

Also reported on the recent RiverPark cleanup. She mentioned the Enhancement line item on the Town Budget and for thoughts on how to spend that money.

Commissioner Smith made a motion to adjourn.

Seconded by Commissioner Reavis
