Cameron Coleman of the Piedmont Regional Triad Council, spoke to the Board on a Comprehensive Land Use Development Plan for Davie County. He asked the Board and audience to share some of their ideas that would better help PTRC coordinate future development policies and initiatives. A fairly good dialog took place.

Motion made by Commissioner Smith to nominate Doug Arledge to a three year term as Alternate , on the Planning Board to replace the recent vote for Jerry Loftin. (Jerry Loftin turned down the position within a couple days of being voted on.)
Seconded by Commissioner Almond.
Vote was unanimous.

A Road Update was discussed. The Board questioned when speed bumps, painting the existing speed bumps, and guard rail at Joyner was going to be done. Speed bumps have be commissioned for 1 on the upper end of Duke and 2 at the lower end of Duke. Commissioner Reavis will report at the October meeting of the progress.

The Town Board have been looking at a couple oak trees in the Playground and Zachary House Grounds.

Motion made by Commissioner Reavis to have these two trees removed by Modern Tree Service and to use the Smith-Davis Gift of \$5000.00 to pay for the work.
Seconded by Commissioner Cover
Vote was unanimous.

The Board briefly discussed the open position of Police Chief. They has previously decided to advertise the position in the News paper. To run the advertisement twice in the Davie Co. Enterprise and once in the Salisbury Post on a Sunday.

The Board discussed various items that needed to be purchased for recreation. Grant money had been received and the items need to be purchased. Details on items to be bought will be discussed at the October meeting.
