RIVERPARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

- All persons shall abide by the posted hours of operation. No Trespassing on RiverPark premises after hours..
- ENTER AT YOUR OWN RISK Anyone entering the RiverPark premises, does so entirely at their own risk. Everyone else connected therewith shall have no liability whatsoever for any claims of any person or loss or damage to any property.
- **KEEP IT CLEAN** All garbage and litter must be deposited in trash/recycle containers provided or taken with you when you leave. No Dumping. No Pollution. No person shall throw, discharge or otherwise place or cause to be placed in the river or anywhere in the park, any substances that would result in pollution of the waters.
- **BEHAVE!** Be thoughtful of others. Engaging in any criminal or disorderly conduct of any kind is prohibited. Destruction of any kind to park property is prohibited.

PROHIBITED

- 1. Campfires, grilling and open flames of any kind except on permanently installed park provided grills.
- 2. Alcoholic beverages or drugs of any kind
- 3. ANY glass bottles or containers
- 4. Pollution of any kind which affects the air, water or ground
- Motorized vehicles on all other park grounds outside of designated parking lots. Motorized vehicles include any motorcycle, all-terrain vehicle (ATV), motorbike, motor scooter, motorized go-cart, golf cart or any other motor vehicle.
- 6. Smoking
- 7. Fireworks or other explosives
- 8. Hunting or trapping

- 9. Destruction of any kind to park premises. Carving, chopping, cutting, and graffiti to any live trees or natural habitat is prohibited. No person shall remove, destroy, cut down, scar, paint, mutilate, injure, take or gather in any manner any tree, flower, fern, shrub, rock or other plant or mineral inside the park premises.
- 10. The creation of any unreasonably loud, disturbing and unnecessary noise
- 11. Engaging in criminal or disorderly conduct of any kind is strictly prohibited.
- 12. Structures, including a "lean-to," shall not be constructed or erected on the park premises.

PERMITS REQUIRED

- 1. Camping of any kinds requires a permit issued by the Town of Cooleemee.
- 2. Saddle or pack animals are only allowed where authorized by posted instructions and with permit issued by the Town of Cooleemee.
- 3. Airplanes, flying machines, drones, hot air balloons, parachutes or other apparatus of aviation are prohibited except by permit issued by the Town of Cooleemee.
- 4. Solicitation, peddling, begging, or the sale of merchandise within the park premises is prohibited without a permit issued by the Town of Cooleemee.
- 5. Signs, banners, notices, and advertisement of any nature or type are prohibited without written permission from RiverPark Board of Directors, and permit issued by the Town of Cooleemee.

PETS AND OTHER ANIMALS

- 1. Pets must be restrained or on a leash at all times while on park premises
- 2. Pick up your pet's poop!

HUNTING AND FISHING

- 1. Hunting and trapping is prohibited
- 2. Fishing is allowed with proper state issued fishing license

FIREARMS, WEAPONS No person shall carry, use, or possess firearms of any description, air rifles, pistols, spring guns, bows and arrows, slingshots, boomerangs, water pistols, or any other form of weapon potentially dangerous to wildlife or human safety on or inside RiverPark at Cooleemee Falls facilities or grounds; except at and in accordance with the rules and regulations as a participant in a program sponsored by RiverPark or law enforcement officer or as stated in G.S. 14-409.40. or other applicable statues of Davie County and Rowan County.
