## **Updates**

Aaron gave an update that the ARAP report had been submitted for the year. Also the insurance policies had been completed and quotes were back with. Aaron stated that there was a 9.4% increase cross the board on the insurance this year. Aaron also said he cut the value on pool buildings to help save money on the insurance. Aaron said there was still issue with the printer and the company had not returned a phone call. New flags and flag pole ropes where in the office to be stalled. For the first quarter 72 violations were sent out with 47 for the month of April being sent out. Riverpark road closer meeting with Hank Van Hoy was on 3/22 and the document had been drawn up to be signed to get the right a way closed.

Went over the area of increase revenues since collections had changed. Tax, Misc. Income, Sales tax, ABC, Civil, Code and Nuisance as well as new income CHA was increase on average of .5% to 2%. Aaron then went over the changes for town hall and police department since the insurance went up. Aaron read over all the items in the budget and asked if anyone had questions. Commissioner Reavis asked if increasing special pick up would be smart with cost of everything going up. The board agree to increase the landfill part \$400 to make it \$1000.00. Aaron last said with the change made to inscrease the pick up the contingency would drop down to \$14,027.00 for the year.
